tion will provide the keynote address. Det. Koven will discuss solutions to equipment and construction crime based on his extensive investigative background and casework. Recently, he concluded a 33-count felony conviction case involving stolen and exported construction equipment.

Equipment theft appears to be on the increase and this session will provide you and your employees with

strategies to help make your company less vulnerable to thieves. Whether you own or rent equipment, this session is designed for you. Don't fall prey to increasing theft during these hard economic times. Learn how to assess and prevent the most common security mistakes that thieves look for on construction sites.

## CICP IS WORKING: 2008 year netted big results.

This year 68 losses were reported to CICP valuing over one million dollars. We are pleased to report that during 2008 there were 29 arrests, 8 recoveries, 5 con-

victions. Several court dates are still pending.

Since CICP began in March of 1996 \$11,338,828 in losses of construction tools,

material and equipment have been reported to CICP. During that same period CICP participated in recoveries of \$3,561,526.
