## CICP Celebrates 12th Annual Awards Luncheon

The Construction Industry Crime Prevention Program of the Pacific Northwest (CICP) honored extraordinary work of law enforcement and contractors at the 12th Annual Awards Luncheon ceremony held March 11, 2008 in Portland. Rep. Scott Bruun, who was instrumental in the passage of the bill to help stop metal theft was the keynote speaker.

Detective Pandora Parks of the Portland Police Bureau was honored with the Law Enforcement Award for her work identifying the owner of a \$7000 trailer. The trailer was delivered at night and when the "new owner" saw it in daylight, he suspected it was stolen and called the police. Det Parks was assigned the case, found no serial numbers, pin numbers or other identifying marks on the trailer. She forwarded pictures she took of the trailer to CICP for distribution to the CICP network. As a result, within 24 hours the real owner was identified and the trailer was returned.

EC Company, and Detective Neil Halttunen of Springfield Police Department were honored with the Law enforcement Partner Award for their actions in apprehending thieves suspected of stealing copper wire and brass fittings valued at nearly \$50,000. Halttunen, working very closely with EC Company, arrested three suspected metal thieves three weeks after being assigned to the detectives unit. The three thieves are now serving sentences up to 62 months.

The Linn County Sheriff's Office Neighborhood Watch Council and the Central Electrical Training Center-Tangent, OR was honored with the CICP Partnership Award. The Linn County Sheriff's Office Neighborhood Watch Council asked CICP to make a presentation to local contractors, many of whom were experiencing metal thefts. The Central Electrical Training Center offered their state of the art facility for this training. The event, the first of its kind in Linn County, was well attended and contractors learned many ways to make themselves less vulnerable to metal thieves.

The prestigious CICP Padlock Award was presented to Glenn Anderson, EC Company for his ingenuity in using hunting cameras for night time surveillance on a construction site. The cameras he installed netted pictures of two men on the jobsite in the middle of the night. Those two men later pled guilty to theft and are serving up to 62 months in the state penitentiary.
