### CICP Is Working

Since it began in March of 1996 \$11,101,478 in losses of construction tools, material and equipment have been reported to CICP. During that same period CICP participated in recoveries of \$3,543,026.

### Membership Benefit – Try This For A Break From Rising Costs

CICP is always looking for ways to provide members with extra benefits. Did you ever wonder how to turn your CICP Membership into cost savings on insurance premiums? 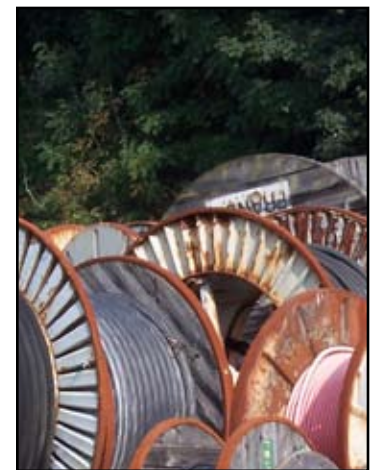
CICP is working with NER on a deductible waiver for our members of up to \$10,000 when scheduled equipment is registered with NER. An extra bonus will be a discount

on the initial registration fees. For members with ten pieces of scheduled equipment, the cost would be approximately \$75. Watch for more details.

### Ongoing Progress: One Goal - Reduce Metal Theft

CICP remains diligent in its work on behalf of the construction industry through active partnerships with the Agriculture Industry, Public Utilities, Law Enforcement and Recyclers. Oregon House Bill 3026 established a good foundation to address the metal theft issue in Oregon. One aspect of the bill requires a recycler to take video surveillance or

a photograph of the seller AND a photocopy of a drivers license, state ID or passport. This surveillance and ID process has led to several arrests of suspected metal thieves. In the not-to-distant future CICP will be asking for additional input from our members and partners so that we can work effectively on improving the current legislation.
